In Manitoba and Canada those who work in Early Learning and Child Care environments have a code of Ethics to guide our standards of practice. Using this code is a professional obligation.

Part I – Explores relationships among beliefs, values and ethics and how these impact your actions. This also broadens our understanding of others.

Part II – In this session the MCCA code of Ethics is introduced as the field's core professional principles and how they are "live" in our daily work. The code becomes our primary tool in ethical practice.

Part III – In this session, the complexity of Best Choice decision making becomes more apparent. You will explore what should be considered prior to making the best choice when faced with Ethical dilemmas. Using the code, you will practice developing a mindful process of ethical decision making.

Facilitators: Jenifer Nick – Jenifer is an ECE and is currently the director of Riverside Daycare in Thompson, Mb. Jenifer has been in the child care field since 2006.

Sarah Nick – Sarah is from Thompson, Mb and is currently the assistant director at Riverside Daycare. She has been working in the child care field in a variety of positions since 2006.
