

## MANAGING AND LEADING IN THE CHILD CARE SECTOR 2.0 RURAL EDITION

WHAT:

Managing and Leading 2.0 is a five-day training event for Executive Directors who are new to the position (1-5 years) and for Assistant Directors who will be moving into the Director's role within the next couple of years. This five-day training is being offered to rural/northern Manitoba directors/assistant directors.

WHEN:

The training will take place from June 16 - 20, 2025, 9:00 am - 4:00 pm daily. You must attend all five days. The training will take place in Brandon, Manitoba at the Clarion Hotel.

WHO:

Directors will be given first priority and spots will be evenly distributed amongst the regions in Manitoba depending on applications. This means that if there are 25 spots, we will try to select at least 3 per region to participate. If there is not enough applicants from a certain region and these spots will be disbursed accordingly to the amount of applications. This training is open to all MCCA members and non MCCA members who are classified as an ECE II or III.

COST:

This five day training is being offered at no cost to participants as part of the Canada Wide ELCC agreement. The participant will be required to pay a deposit to confirm their spot. This deposit will be \$300.00 and will be refunded right after the training. Should the participant not attend the training the deposit will not be refunded.

What is included:

- ·5 days of leadership training
- **.**5 nights of accommodations (Sunday-Thursday)
- ·Breakfast and Lunch (Monday Friday)
- ·Substitution subsidy for those who will require it

What is not included:

- ·Transportation costs to and from Brandon
- ·Dinners
- ·Incidental expenses

PROCESS:

- Eligible Directors/Assistant Directors submit an application to MCCA by February 21, 2025.
- Applications are reviewed and 25 participants will be selected.
- Confirmation letter will be sent and refundable deposit will be requested.
- Deposit sent to MCCA by Mar. 17th, 2025.
