Manitoba Best Practices Licensing Manual for Early Learning and Child Care Centres recommends 24 hours of professional development per year for ECEs and CCAs. MCCA offers workshops (in-person and virtually), institutes, and conferences that members can attend at a reduced rate. Members located outside of Winnipeg can attend workshops in their region, which are organized by the regional branches. Our annual provinicial conference is held in May. Travel subsidy is available for this event for those members located outside of Winnipeg. The conference brochure will provide all the conference details.



What is a Regional Branch?

Regional branches are established by local MCCA members who volunteer their time to support and advance MCCA's mission within their area. Each branch is guided by a Regional Board, elected by members in that region. The Board is responsible for organizing professional development opportunities, representing regional concerns and needs to the Provincial Board, and leading local advocacy efforts. Active branches are eligible to receive a 10% rebate of membership dues collected from members in their region, which can be used to support branch activities and initiatives.

How do I become a member?

Complete an <u>Individual Membership Application</u>. You can print one from our website www.mccahouse.org. Choose your payment option and submit the application with your fees (if you are not on payroll remittance). Annual fees can be pro-rated for the number of months remaining in the membership year.

Borrowing Resources from the library:

Yes, a list of library resources is on our website. Click on professional development, and then resource library. We will mail the books of your choice to you. You can return the books using the postage paid return mail labels we provide to you.





How am I notified when there is a event or workshop happening in my region?

Regional branch updates and event information are shared through multiple channels to keep you informed and connected. Most branches will notify your child care centre, while some may send information directly to individual members. In addition, MCCA will send emails to members on behalf of their regional branch to ensure you don't miss out on local opportunities.

I live in a region that doesn't have an active branch. Who organizes professional development for me?

MCCA's head office will coordinate at least one professional development event each year for members in inactive regions. Event details will be included in the fall and winter workshop brochures featured in Child Care Bridges magazine, and may also be emailed directly to members in those regions.





Professional Development Schedule

Most workshops are held in the fall and the winter. Information about workshops is included in the September and December issue of Child Care Bridges. Workshops and other upcoming events can be found on our website at www.mccahouse.org and online registration begins end of August for fall workshops and early December for winter workshops.

When is Child Care Bridges magazine mailed?

All membership categories (excluding the \$10.00 student membership and \$50.00 retiree membership) include a joint affiliate membership with the Canadian Child Care Federation.

Membership year is from January to December with the exception of student memberships (September 1 - August 31). Receipts are only issued if requested. Individuals working in a facility will receive them by email to the facility. All others are emailed to the emails on file. Receipts for memberships, if requested, will be emailed out by February 28 the following year.

Individual Membership dues that are paid by the member are eligible for a tax receipt.
