



Exceptional Caregiver Award

Nomination Criteria

Nominee:

- Must be a current personal member of MCCA
- Cannot be nominated by anyone they are related to
- Previous recipients of this award and MCCA provincial board members are not eligible for nomination
- Must be a frontline caregiver, classified as a child care assistant, currently employed in an MCCA member centre or nursery school
- Must have at least 3 years experience in the child care field

An exceptional Child Care Assistant (CCA) is an early childhood education professional who supports early childhood educators in providing care for children. Their role includes assisting with programs that promote children's development, helping with daily routines, and ensuring a safe and nurturing environment for all children, including those with additional support needs.

Nominator:

- Two MCCA members employed in the centre must sign the nomination form
- The centre or nursery school director must sign the nomination form
- A letter of support from a parent user from the facility

Award Recipients will:

- Be presented with a plaque
- Receive 1 complimentary ticket to the conference banquet
- Have name inscribed on a plaque at MCCA
- Will be profiled in the fall issue of *Child Care Bridges* and/or MCCA's website
- Recipient may be profiled on MCCA's social media platforms
