Nomination Criteria


The purpose of this award is to encourage and support thesis, dissertation or comparable research projects at a graduate level that is applicable to the child care field. Topics may include child care centre design, children and outdoor play, child developmental issues, indigenous teachings in ECE, culture & diversity, family involvement or social issues such as child poverty, family support, etc.

## Applicant:

- · Must be a Manitoba resident
- Must be a current personal MCCA member
- Previous recipients of this award and MCCA provincial board members are not eligible for nomination
- Must be registered full or part-time in a graduate program at an accredited university
- Must have had their proposal accepted for thesis; dissertation, or comparable research project (not included are papers related to course work)
- Ensure their research topic is applicable to the child care field as determined by the Awards Committee appointed by the Manitoba Child Care Association
- Must be able to report the results of the research project at the annual MCCA conference (at the discretion of the MCCA Conference Committee)

## Award Recipients will:

- Receive a monetary award of \$500.00
- Be presented with a plaque
- Receive 1 complimentary ticket to the conference banquet
- Have name inscribed on a plaque at MCCA
- Will be profiled in the fall issue of Child Care Bridges and/or MCCA's website
- Recipient may be profiled on MCCA's social media platforms
