The Cheryl Brockington award is presented by the Manitoba Child Care Association Thompson Region in recognition of outstanding contribution made by Cheryl to the Early Childhood Education Profession in Northern Manitoba.

The Cheryl Brockington Award was created in memory of Cheryl who served as the Day Care Coordinator within Thompson, MB and surrounding communities.

This award is a major recognition by MCCA Thompson Region of the work of an individual who has made outstanding contributions to the Early Childhood Profession.

Nominees taken into consideration will be employed at a Childcare Facility, Family Child Care Providers, be a member of MCCA, Board Member of MCCA, a qualified ECE II or III (includes Directors & ECE Instructors, Child Care Coordinator), Child Care Assistant and Student Members.

The potential recipient will have made contributions in the early childhood educational field that are well beyond the call of duty.

Some characteristics to consider:

- Provides a safe and nurturing environment that meets the Manitoba Child Day Care Licensing requirements to prevent and reduce injuries.
- Demonstrates that he/she establishes good health and nutrition practices and provides an enjoyable environment.
- Provides an interesting and enjoyable environment that encourages exploration and learning for children.
- Provides opportunities to promote the physical development of children.
- Provides activities and experiences that develop questioning, probing, exploration and problem solving appropriate to the developmental levels and learning styles of children.
- Provides opportunities for children to understand acquire and use verbal and non-verbal means of communication thoughts and feelings.
- Provides experiences that encourages and stimulates children to explore and express their creative abilities.
- Provides opportunity for each child to know, accept, and take pride in them and develop a sense of independence.
- Provides opportunities for children to learn to get along with others and encourages feelings of empathy and mutual respect among children and adults.
- Provides a respectful environment where children can learn and practice appropriate behaviors.

- Demonstrates an open, friendly and informative relationship with each child's family and encourages family involvement and builds community partnerships in the child care program.

- Demonstrates organization, plans, keeps records and effectively manages the program.

- Demonstrates that they practice a personal philosophy of early childhood education that follows ethical and professional standards.

- Demonstration of going over and above the call of duty to ensure to meet the skills, abilities and interests of all children.

- Demonstration of professional development participation to enhance their child care skills when working with children, families, co-workers and community.
