Reflective Learning Institute Overview With Lorrie McGee Baird and Anne Marie Coughlin

As people who live and work with the earth's youngest humans, we make decisions every day that have an extraordinary impact on children, ourselves and our communities. As early childhood educators and leaders, how might we start to evolve our approach to early learning and take up the work of creating inclusive, vibrant learning communities in a way that is responsive to our times? How might we nurture an approach to leadership that is constructed around relationships rather than rules? How do we focus our teaching practices around compassion, curiosity, imagination, experimentation, collaboration, innovation, and kindness?



Anne Marie Coughlin and Lorrie Baird are Pedagogical Leaders and Early Learning Mentors from Ontario, Canada. Individually they lead pedagogy and professional learning programs for large multi-site child care organizations. Together they offer Learning Institutes across Ontario, Canada and the US that offer unique, engaging and meaningful experiences for teachers and administrators.
